


MV41

Quick Reference Guide



Introduction

Our MV41 is an advanced 4x1 HDMI multi-view switcher. The MV41 allows up to 4 x HDMI 2.0 sources to be output to a single display at the same time, with pre-defined and customisable video layouts, and seamless switching. The MV41 also supports HDMI loop-through for all HDMI inputs allowing cascading of original source signals for further distribution.

The MV41 features 2ch PCM and Optical S/PDIF audio break, with third party control achievable from the web-GUI, TCP/IP, RS-232, IR remote control, of from the front panel buttons.


The multiple configuration and connectivity options make the MV41 suitable for both residential and commercial installations

FEATURES:

- Advanced 4 x HDMI input switch with multi-view HDMI output
- Features 4 x HDMI loop out for integrating local displays or cascading to multiple devices
- Supports PIP, PBP, POP, Dual, Triple and Quad-windows layouts with pre-defined and customisable configurations
- Supports video down-scaling and HDR to SDR conversion on HDMI multi-view output
- Supports HDMI 2.0 4K UHD 60Hz 4:4:4 18Gbps specification including HDR
- Supports all industry standard video resolutions including VGA-WUXGA and 480i-4K
- Supports all known HDMI audio formats including Dolby Atmos, Dolby TrueHD, Dolby Digital Plus and DTS-HD Master Audio transmission
- HDMI audio breakout to analogue L/R audio, and optical digital outputs concurrently
- Analogue L/R audio outputs support both balanced and unbalanced audio signals
- Control via front panel, IR, RS-232, TCP/IP, web-GUI and 12v trigger
- Supplied with Blustream 5v IR receiver and remote control
- 3rd party drivers available for major control brands
- HDCP 2.3 compliant with advanced EDID management




Front Panel



- IR Receiver Window
- 2 Power Status LED Indicator Illuminates when the device is powered
- 3 Select button press to toggle between HDMI inputs (1 > 2 > 3 > 4 > 1...). Auto-switching function is enabled / disabled by pressing and holding the Select button for 5 seconds. Input light will flash 3 times to confirm switching function enabled / disabled
- 4 Output LED Indicator Indicates if a display device is connected to the switches HDMI output
- 6 Input LED indicators displays the HDMI inputs currently active
- 6 Multi-View Button Press to toggle between multiview modes
- Resolution Button Press to toggle between output resolutions
- Upgrade Port Micro USB port for firmware updates

Rear Panel



- 1 TCP/IP Port RJ45 connector for TCP/IP and web-GUI control of the device
- ® RS-232 Port 3-pin Phoenix connector for RS-232 control of the device
- 1 IR Control Input 3.5mm stereo connector to connect to Blustream IR receiver for IR control of the device
- # HDMI Inputs Connect to HDMI source devices
- B HDMI Loop Outputs Connect to local HDMI devices, splits signal from corresponding HDMI input
- 4 HDMI Output connect to local display device, Matrix, or Video over IP transmitter
- 6 Optical S/PDIF Output De-embed digital audio from the selected HDMI input
- Analogue Audio Left/Right Output 5-pin Phoenix connector to de-embed balanced or unbalanced audio from the selected HDMI input. Source audio input must be PCM 2 channel audio for the analogue output to work. Please note: the MV41 does not down-mix multi-channel audio signals

- BDID DIP switches See User Manual on the Blustream website for more information
- DC Power Port Use supplied Blustream 12v/2A DC adaptor to power the device



Web-GUI Control

The MV41 features an in-built web-GUI which can be used for control and configuration of the device. By default the MV41 is set to DHCP however if a DHCP server (eg: network router) is not installed, the switch IP address will revert to the below details:

Default **Username** is: blustream Default **Password** is: 1234 Default **IP Address** is: 192.168.0.200



Multiview

The MV41 provides advanced multi-view functionality to allow 4 x sources to be displayed simultaneously on 1 x HDMI display. The MV41's web-GUI provides an easy to use interface to allow control of the multi-view functionality. It provides the following key functionality:


- Drag and drop source devices (inputs) onto specific output windows
- Pre-defined multi-view layouts and user configurable custom layouts
- Selectable audio source from HDMI inputs
- Auto-switching enable/disable
